## Title IV Compliance

The California Department of Education (CDE) has issued the Education Equity 2015-16 Program Instrument used to monitor local educational agency (LEA) compliance with laws on equity in the treatment of students. The guidance identifies a new Title IX reporting requirement enacted by Senate Bill (SB) 1349 in 2014.

SB 1349 added section 221.9 to the Education Code, requiring that, beginning with the 2015-16 school year, school sites (including charter schools) publish: (1) total school enrollment, classified by gender; (2) total number of students who participate in athletics, classified by gender; and (3) total number of school athletic teams, classified by gender, sport and competition level. This information must be posted to the school's website.

- (1) Total school enrollment, classified by gender: 256 males and 221 females
- (2) Total number of students who participate in athletics, classified by gender:
  105 males and 88 females

(3) Total number of school athletic teams, classified by gender, sport and competition level.
